Nomination Deadline: February 15, 2018

Decision: The Awards Committee will select recipients by end of February 2018, and winners will be notified shortly thereafter.

Recognition: Winners names will be listed in the COA e-Newsletter INFO-FLASH. Awards will be presented at the Award Gala in March 2018.

General Information

- Only one nomination is required for each nominee.
- The nominee must give consent.
- Applications can be in English or French.

Letter of Support: Please provide a letter of support (no more than 300 words). The letter should:

- Be written by someone who has benefiting directly from the nominee's contribution or by someone who knows the nominee well.
- Provide details of the contribution. Include examples of their leadership, community service, commitment, creativity, or influence in the community.

Evaluation of Nominations: A Selection Committee will consider nominees who show:

Leadership: leadership through planning, organizing or starting a new project or program for seniors and/or the wider community.

Service: a special skill or talent, or knowledge.

Time Commitment: The time dedicated is noteworthy.

Influence: the contribution improves the community and the age-friendliness of Ottawa.

Creativity: The contribution is unique and demonstrates thoughtfulness of senior's needs.
